

# Ravenwood Forest Association Proxy Basics

A Proxy allows someone else to vote for you in the event you can't make an Association meeting. Assigning a proxy helps you maintain your interests and also helps the meeting itself move forward without worry over an absent member. When you can't be there, the Ravenwood Forest Association Proxy helps get your voice heard.

## Use the Association Proxy document if:

- You want to vote at the Association meeting, but can't be there.
- You need to tell your proxy how to vote.
- You'd like to ensure the meeting makes quorum.

When you can't be there in person, the Ravenwood Forest Association Proxy can let you vote. Maybe there's an issue on the table you really care about: like changes to quiet hours or the introduction of a neighborhood watch, but what if you'll be out of town? What if you have other obligations? As long as you have a proxy you can see to your prior engagements while maintaining your vote. You also want to make sure your proxy is voting how you'd like, after all, they're representing you. Having the agreement in writing can help you avoid issues and help your proxy remember exactly what your stance is on each important issue. Using a Ravenwood Forest Association Proxy can help you participate in meetings even when you can't attend.
