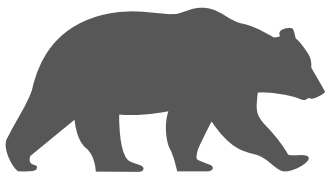

Bet you didn't know that every week there are 6-7 garbage pick-up services in Ravenwood-that means 12-14 garbage/recycling trucks every single week. Yikes!!

Etowah Lions is the overwhelming predominate garbage service, with Waste Pro a distant second. For the 50± homes that use the services, 5 of the companies serve only 1 or 2 homes. A huge waste of fuel and time, not to mention the wear and tear on our roads.
